

READY GOLF ETIQUETTE

1. Be at your ball, ready to hit when it is your turn. Do away with “honors”. Let the shorter distance hitters play if the group in front is out of their range.
2. Keep an eye on each other’s shots so you can find any ball.
3. Carry an extra ball in your pocket and take 2 or 3 clubs to your ball when playing cart path only golf.
4. Study the line of your putt while others prepare to putt.
5. Don’t walk in the line of another player’s putt.
6. Ask the player putting if they want the flag in or out.
7. Remain quiet on greens and tees when players are ready to hit.
8. Repair all ball marks and replace your divots in the fairways and rake sand in bunkers.
9. Keep carts and bags off greens and away from the front of the greens fringe area.
10. After your group has holed out, move immediately to the next tee and record scores there.
11. Put your cell phone on silent on the course.
