## **READY GOLF ETIQUETTE**

- 1. Be at your ball, ready to hit when it is your turn. Do away with "honors". Let the shorter distance hitters play if the group in front is out of their range.
- 2. Keep an eye on each other's shots so you can find any ball.
- 3. Carry an extra ball in your pocket and take 2 or 3 clubs to your ball when playing cart path only golf.
- 4. Study the line of your putt while others prepare to putt.
- 5. Don't walk in the line of another player's putt.
- 6. Ask the player putting if they want the flag in or out.
- 7. Remain quiet on greens and tees when players are ready to hit.
- 8. Repair all ball marks and replace your divots in the fairways and rake sand in bunkers.
- 9. Keep carts and bags off greens and away from the front of the greens fringe area.
- 10. After your group has holed out, move immediately to the next tee and record scores there.
- 11. Put your cell phone on silent on the course.
